HOW DO I VOTE IF I AM AWAY AT COLLEGE?

If you are away at college or are unable to go to your local polling location on November 6, you may vote by either obtaining an absentee ballot from your town clerk, or you may vote during the early voting period, October 22 – November 2. The exact times each day will be posted on the Town Clerk's website. Please subscribe to news notifications and you will receive an email detailing the exact hours that the Mashpee Town Clerk will hold Early Voting. It should be noted that each town has different hours set for Early Voting.
